FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What happens to BMR now?

The current funds in the BMR will only be expended for major building repair and maintenance issues—just like it always has. You made a contribution to the church for this specific purpose and we will continue to honor that. Unfortunately, the building does have some large expense surprises every year.

How much do these new projects cost?

Baptismal Font—estimated \$10,000

Recovering of chairs—estimated \$15,000 (500 chairs @ \$30 per chair)

Repair of roof—estimated \$8,000

Tile in worship space—estimated \$25,725 (3,675 sq ft @ \$7 per sq ft labor and material)

How can we afford these new projects?

We will only be able to afford these projects if you make it happen. Each of the projects will be pre-funded by your contributions. We hope that you will be as generous as possible early so these enhancements can be realized sooner than later. Ideally, the Holy Spirit will work miracles and we can begin shortly after Easter.

When does POPE begin?

POPE begins the first weekend in February, (February 5 & 6), with monthly collections thereafter.

Will there be more phases?

Yes. A group of active parishioners (including Parish Council and Finance council members) met in a focus group and expressed a desire to start our long-discussed renovation by doing little projects. Nobody really wants to wait 3+ years before any activity begins. So, a laundry list of projects was identified that will be incorporated into future phases. Based on the timing and completion of Phase I, Fr. Scott will consult with the Parish Council, Finance Council and other parishioners to determine the next set of priorities.
